





Keeping Our Township Clean, Safe & Green



The township has recently undergone a series of maintenance and upkeep works aimed at ensuring a cleaner, safer and more pleasant living environment. Fresh turfing was carried out along riverbanks and sloped areas, not only enhancing the greenery but also helping to prevent soil erosion and stabilise the landscape.

At the same time, a large-scale drain clearing exercise was conducted, with workers and machinery removing silt, debris and overgrown vegetation to restore smooth water flow and reduce the risk of flooding. Teams also collected rubbish, branches and leaves from public areas, ensuring that shared spaces remain tidy and welcoming for residents.

Road kerbs received a facelift with thorough water-jet cleaning followed by a fresh coat of white paint, while road markings were repainted in bright yellow to improve visibility and safety for motorists. Overgrown trees were trimmed and pruned, removing potential hazards while enhancing the township's overall appearance.

These combined efforts underscore the ongoing commitment to maintaining the township's cleanliness, safety and beauty, creating a community that residents can take pride in.

Ongoing maintenance efforts continue across the township, with regular drain clearing to prevent blockages, daily watering to support healthy landscaping, and the removal of rubbish and wood stumps around persiaran Tan Sri Low Yow Chuan to keep the surroundings clean and tidy.
